





#### Maintenance:

PlayCourt requires minimal maintenance although debris and detritus (mud. leaves or grit) should be removed on a regular basis by gentle brushing or vacuuming. Should algae, moss, weeds or grass develop on the surface, these should be treated with a suitable weed killer as soon as possible (when required, moss killer containing Dichlorophen should be used and oil based moss killers avoided). Weeds and grass should not be pulled up until they have died to prevent disruption to the surface. Frequent power washing should be avoided (applied cold with a mild, non-foaming detergent if deemed necessary). Steam cleaners should never be used.

- When determined in accordance with DD 229: 1996, a playground surfaced with 6mm Breedon Playcourt was found to have a mean relative hydraulic conductivity of 29,120mm/hr. The mean water infiltration rate for a play area constructed using 6mm Breedon Playcourt was 8,097mm/hr, when tested to the requirements of BS EN 12616: 2003. These results demonstrate a high level of porosity.
